COMPETITIVE CALL FOR RESEARCH AWARDS YITP 2019 ACRI - XV SIMAI CONGRESS (SIMAI 2020+21)

ART. 1 – Description and summary sheet

With reference to the year 2021, a competitive call for the awarding of research prizes, funded by ACRI (Association of Foundations and Banks Savings SpA) through the Young Investigator Training Program (YITP) 2019, is launched, in the framework of the of the XV Congress of the Italian Society for Applied and Industrial Mathematics - SIMAI 2020 + 21 - which will take place at the University of Parma from 30 August to 03 September 2021.

The awards are intended for young scholars currently affiliated to foreign Research Centers who will have to attend the SIMAI 2020 + 21 Congress by presenting a scientific contribution in the YITP Minisymposium and to spend at least one month in one of the qualified Italian institutions affiliated to the Program, indicated in next ART. 2, carrying out collaborative research activities exclusively, not supported by other funding. The month of stay can be divided into several periods and must be carried out by 30 November 2021.

The prizes, which will be awarded by the Department of Mathematical, Physical and Computer Sciences of the University of Parma, will consist of a contribution, intended as gross amount and inclusive of any charges required by current regulations, of 3000 euros for researchers coming from the European area and 4000 euros for researchers coming from the non-European area.

Affiliation to a foreign Research Center (permanent or temporary position, scholarship, research grant, others)

€ 3000 for researchers coming from European area

€ 4000 for researchers coming from the non-European area.

The above prizes, intended as gross amounts and inclusive of any charges required by current regulations, will be paid in a single instalment deferred at the end of the visiting period.

ART. 3 - Admission requirements

This Call is intended for young scholars

- with affiliation to foreign Universities or Research Centers
- under 40 years of age



who will attend SIMAI 2020+21 Congress, from 30 August to 3 September 2021, at the University of Parma.

Participation to the selection procedures for the awarding of research prizes is precluded to those who have a degree of kinship or affinity (up to and including the fourth degree) or marriage relationship with a member belonging to the structure requesting the activation of the prizes or with the Rector, the General Manager or a member of the University Board.

The requisites must be possessed at the deadline for the application submission. The Selection Committee may order at any time the exclusion from the selection for lack of the prescribed requirements.

ART. 4 - Application submission

The application must be submitted **no later than:**

01/05/2021

ART. 5 – Required documentation

Under penalty of exclusion from the procedure, the following documentation has to be sent in order to participate to the competition:

- a) Application form (All.1) fully completed under applicant's own responsibility, dated and signed, indicating:
 - surname and name, date and place of birth, citizenship, home address
 - affiliation
 - e-mail address
 - title and authors of the scientific contribution to be submitted at YITP-SIMAI2020+21 minisymposium
 - selection of 3 possible Research Centers
 - proposed period of stay (minimum 1 month, also divisible, possibly including the week of Congress attendance
 - research project to be developed at the hosting Italian Research Center
- b) Curriculum vitae
- c) List of scientific publications



- d) Possible support letters (max 2)
- e) Copy of a valid identification document

ART. 6 - Selection committee and evaluation criteria

The selection will be undertaken by a Committee composed by three members, internal and external to the University of Parma, appointed by Department provision, which will carry out a comparative evaluation of the candidates, according to the following merit criteria, in agreement with ACRI:

- scientific career (CV);
- quality of developed research (publications);
- possible support letters (max 2);
- research project to be developed at the hosting Italian Research Center.

The maximum score attributable to each candidate is set at 100 points; eligibility is achieved with a minimum score of 60.

The Commission will define the related merit ranking of eligible candidates, indicating the winners of the research prize, i.e. the first candidates usefully positioned up to the total amount of ACRI funding. In the event of equal merit, the youngest candidate will prevail.

The Commission's judgment is unquestionable.

ART. 7 - Publication of the competitive call and final ranking; notification of results

The winners will be notified to their e-mail address indicated in the application form; in the aforementioned communication, the host institution will also be assigned to each winner.

ART. 8 - Winners: methods of acceptance

The winners will have to submit:

Failure to receive such documentation within the indicated terms will implicitly represent the rejection of the prize by the winning candidate and will result in the scrolling of the ranking of eligible candidates with an appropriate postponement of the terms for documents submission.

ART. 9 – Duties of the winners and payment of the award; revocation of the prize

The research activity of the winners must take place **exclusively** at the host Center following the provisions in force in the Research Center, also concerning health and safety at work.

The research award will be paid in the gross amount before the charges provided for by law, including those borne by the University Administration, once the winners have submitted the following documentation:

- abstract of the talk given at YITP SIMAI 2020+21 minisymposium
- certification, by the Research Center contact people, of the period of stay at the institution by the winner
- report of the scientific activity carried out at the host Research Center and of the results obtained in collaboration at the end of the monthly visiting period.

The disbursement of the research award does not imply in any way an employment relationship either with the University providing the funds or with the host organization. The prize cannot be combined with other funds, conferred for any reason.

If during the research activity the conditions set for the awarding of the prize are no longer met, the researcher must immediately notify **protocollodipscienzemfi@unipr.it**.

The award may be revoked in the following cases:

- subsequent renunciation of the winner
- agreed monthly period not completed

b) PURPOSE AND METHODS OF TREATMENT

d) RIGHTS OF THE INTERESTED PARTY
